Q1: What is the fees structure?

Online MBA tuition fees are £6500 which can be paid in easy instalments. £500 discount is offered for full fees payments.

Fees Breakdown

Registration for minimum 3 modules: £1800

Thereafter each module (6 in total) for: £600

Dissertation: £1100

Registration Fees of £250 is in addition to the tuition fees.

Q2: Are there any scholarships and what is the procedure for scholarships?

Yes. The scholarships are offered based on your personal statement, which should highlight the reason for request of scholarships. Key aspects for considering scholarships are:

1. Working in Developing country
2. Working for charity
3. High academic/professional performance
4. Financial assistance

Q2: Are University of Wales and Magna Carta College accredited by British Government?

University of Wales is a public sector university established by Royal charter in 1893. Q3: How long would it take for the course to complete?

The duration of the course depends on your pace of work vis a vis your work life balance. It can take from 18-36 months, but we recommend students to complete it in 18-24 months.

Q4: What is the assessment procedure?

All courses are assessed through course work except for International Sustainability (corporate social responsibility), which is assessed 50% through course work and 50% by online exam. All the assessments can be completed online.



Q5: How can I apply for residential and what are the details of residential?

The dates of residential will be announced once a year in January. You can opt for residential which will incur additional cost which will be published every year in January.

Q6: Will I get the degree from University of Wales and will it mention online?

The degrees are awarded by University of Wales, UK and do not mention mode of study.

Q7: Can I get credit exemptions for post graduate course completed in my country?

Post graduate courses recognised by University of Wales can be considered for credit transfers. Credits are only awarded for the modules/courses which map with our MBA courses.

Q8: How will the course be delivered?

The course is completely delivered online through state of the art virtual learning environment. All learning materials are accessible 24/7. You will need a PC and internet access. Following additional support is also provide to a student:

1. Online tutor
2. Academic support by Academic coordinators
3. Administrative support by admin team
4. Technical support by technical team
5. Supervisor for dissertation

Q10: Is the degree recognised world over and would I get job based on the degree?

Yes, the degree is recognised world over. After completing your MBA, we are confident that it will help you in fast track promotion in your existing company or new job if you are planning to change your job.

Q11: Can I enrol without a degree and what's the procedure?

You can enrol through mature entry route or based on your work experience.

1. Mature Entry Route: For mature entry route, you should have at least 10 years of industrial experience.
2. Work Experience: If you have a qualification not equivalent to UK first degree, you can still qualify for MBA. You will need to provide evidence of work experience for at least 2 years in management role.

Q12: How many residential face-to-face days are there?

None, the course is delivered completely online. There is an optional 2 weeks residential programme which comes at an additional cost.

Q13: Do the recorded audio lectures and lecture notes fully cover the MBA programme?
